



Australian Farm Deaths & Injuries Media Monitors Snapshot January 1 - June 30, 2016

Background

Australian print media provides an avenue to highlight the prevalence of farm related deaths and injuries. The process of media monitoring has been used by the National Farm Injury Data Centre (NFIDC) since 2005 to assist in the collection of information on farm injury events (fatal and nonfatal). This report focuses predominantly on data involving on-farm injury events reported in the Australian print media for the period January 1st to June 30th 2016. It also captures non-farm quad related fatality and injury over the same period.

Deaths

There were approximately 976 print media articles received by the NFIDC from iSENTIA during the period. A total of 30 on-farm deaths were reported:

- The overall number of fatal on-farm cases (n=30) is more than the corresponding period in 2015 (n=24).
- Seven (23.3%) of the 30 deaths involved a child aged 15 years and under.
- Mobile plant and machinery (n=8), tractors (n=4) and quads (n=3) were reported most frequently.
- Media monitoring also captures non-farm quad related fatality. There were three additional
 fatal injury events that occurred off-farm for this period (i.e. there were a total of six quad
 related deaths nationally including farm and non-farm cases).




Figure 1: On-farm deaths reported in Australian print media by age and state, 1st Jan- 30th June 2016.

Non-fatal Injury

There were an additional 44 non-fatal on-farm injury events reported in the Australian print media for the period 1^{st} Jan- 30^{th} June 2016.

- Six (13.6%) of the 44 injury events involved children aged 15 years and under.
- Quad related injury (n=21) accounted for nearly 50% of all incidents. This was followed by cattle related incidents (n=6).
- For quads, there were fifteen additional injuries that occurred off-farm (i.e. there were a total of 36 quad related non-fatal injuries nationally including farm and non-farm cases reported).




Figure 2: On-farm non-fatal injury events reported in Australian print media, 1st Jan- 30th June 2016.
