



Australian Farm Deaths & Injuries Media Monitors Snapshot January 1 - March 31, 2015

Background

Australian print media provides an avenue to highlight the prevalence of farm related deaths and injuries. The process of media monitoring has been used by the National Farm Injury Data Centre (NFIDC) since 2005 to assist in the collection of information on farm injury events (fatal and nonfatal). This report focuses predominantly on data involving on-farm injury events reported in the Australian print media for the period January 1st to March 31st 2015. It also captures non-farm quad bike related fatality and injury over the same period.

Deaths

There were approximately 148 print media articles received by the NFIDC from iSENTIA during the period. A total of 11 on-farm deaths were reported:

- The overall number of fatal cases (n=11) was higher than that for the corresponding period in 2014 (n=7).
- Three (27%) of the 11 deaths involved a child aged 15 years and under.
- Quads (n=4) and tractors (n=3), were reported most frequently.
- Media monitoring also captures non-farm quad bike related fatality. There was one
 additional fatal injury event that occurred off-farm for this period (i.e. there were a total of
 five quad related deaths nationally including farm and non-farm cases).

Non-fatal Injury

There were an additional 29 non-fatal on-farm injury events reported in the Australian print media for the period January 1st to March 31st 2015.

- Two (7%) of the 29 injury events involved children aged 15 years and under.
- Quad related injury (n=11) accounted for 38% of all incidents. This was followed by cattle (n=3) and horse (n=3) related incidents.
- For quads, there were 8 additional injuries that occurred off-farm (i.e. there were a total of 19 quad related non-fatal injuries notified nationally including farm and non-farm cases).




Figure 2: On-farm non-fatal injury events reported in Australian print media, January - March 2015.
