Quad Modifications for Easy Transfer.

Wayne Lewis, a Victorian farmer with a mid level spinal cord injury continues to operate his cattle, sheep and cropping enterprise with the use of modifications to his ute, machinery and house.

Transferring onto the quad can become tiring particularly if there is direct lift from the wheel chair onto the seat of the quad. Wayne has overcome this by building a transfer seat onto the foot plate of his Honda quad. Wayne transfers from the chair onto the transfer seat and then is able to lift himself onto the seat of the quad.

Additionally Wayne has made a padded back rest and bolted it onto the rear loading tray of the quad.

*Note old photo - quads should be fitted with a crush protection device (CPD) or commonly known as a rollbar.
