

Information Sheet 7 Tractor Access: Overhead Winch on a Gantry Frame.


A Tasmanian beef cattle producer developed a low maintenance, low cost, easy way to access his tractor. A winch is fitted to an overhead gantry, fitted to the roll over protective structure of tractor.



He transfers from his quad onto the sling placed on the seat of his wheel chair and clips himself to the winch attached to the gantry frame, which extends outside the line of the rear tyre. He then winches himself up to above the height of the mud guard of the tractor; once at the correct height he slides along the gantry to above the tractor seat and lowers himself down into position and drives away.
