

Information Sheet 10 Pool Access: Hand Winch.

A Victorian with a mid level spinal cord injury continues to operate his cattle, sheep and cropping enterprise after modifications to his machinery and house.

To access the pool, there is fixed hand winch on a frame which is bolted the frame to edge of the pool. The farmer transfers from wheelchair onto the swivel seat, swings out over the pool and winches down in the water. To exit the pool he again sits on the seat and winches himself out to chair height, swings around and transfers again to his chair.



This modification is easy to make, low cost, simple to install, low maintenance, durable, serviceable at home and most importantly easy to use.
